CSAs come in all shapes and sizes. Whether you're select about the veggies you want or working on a budget, there's a CSA for you!


Here in the Upper Valley we have an abundance of family farms offering CSAs, many of which are certified organic. Check out this list of local farms, and find one that's right for you!
